





Harald Altmaier

Harald Altmaier is a master of fine art photography, renowned for his cinematic visual storytelling and highly-detailed images that incorporate floristry, colour and carefully considered artifacts.

His large-scale projects are all based around specific themes; "Eternal Bloom" is a stunning exploration of grandeur, style and elegance.

Using the technique of tableaux, Altmaier renders his compositions in a way that tells a thought-provoking narrative and imbues them with a mystique that leaves the viewer wanting more.

His tableaux are carefully staged scenes and compositions that tell a story, through visual cues and symbolism, by arranging the elements of the scene in a deliberate and thought-provoking way.

Harald manages to create a mood and atmosphere that enhances the message or theme of the arrangement.

His images evoke a wide range of emotions, from beauty and serenity to tension and unease, and can help to engage the viewer's imagination and curiosity simultaneously. With advanced lighting techniques and the best photographic equipment, Harald takes the art of tableaux to new heights, creating images that are both beautiful and evocative.

Harald draws inspiration from 17th & 18th century old Dutch and Flemish master painters. He expertly uses Vermeer lighting and harmonious colours to create visual tensions and sophisticated atmospheres that transport viewers to new worlds. With Harald everything is meticulously planned and strategically placed, to help the viewer to discover the stories for themselves.

Each of Altmaier's arrangements is a work of art in its own right, showcasing his exquisite attention to detail and deep understanding of colour, floristry and the power of storytelling through photography.



A grand fan-shaped bouquet of May blooms appears in all its true glorious colours and hues out of a dark background beautifully lit entirely by carefully guided soft afternoon light.





Soft and diffused daylight creates serenity, enhancing the purity of these delicate white summer blooms in this most lavish of creations. Intricate details emerge from the shadows adding depth and texture to the complexity of the scene.





Silk curtains are drawn back to let natural light flood this stilled scene of late summer blooms, fruit, berries and seed pots. The green guelder flowers beautifully reflect the sunlight and stand out against the green damask. The eye is guided to intricate details of ripening berries and rosehips, deteriorating apples and skeletonised leaves. Some flowers in the arrangement have significant meaning in old Dutch paintings, with garden roses symbolising love and devotion, guelder (viburnum) representing unity and togetherness.

Warm earthy colours set the tone for this abundant autumnal composition of blooms, rosehips, fruit and vegetables.

One light source brightly illuminates the richly coloured flowers and sets them centre stage surrounded by damask, a nobleman's portrait, winged angels and richly coloured vegetables. Deteriorating leaves and some flowers on the verge of losing their beauty remind the viewer how brief the enjoyment of pleasure is.


